

LOCAL RULES

- The rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply
- On Dunas Golf Course only closed up sandy areas are Hazard Bunkers, all other sandy areas are considered Waste Areas.
- Waste Areas or Waste Bunkers are not considered Hazards according to the rules of Golf, so, unlike in Bunkers, golfers are permitted to ground a club lightly in, or remove loose impediments from, the area around the ball.
- At Dunas Golf Course, if the ball lies on a footprint (human or animal) in a Waste Area players can take relief without penalty.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

- Competitors of official competition.
- 3 and 4 ball matches must give way to 2 ball matches.
- A player alone has no standing.
- Players interrupting their round of golf lose their standing.
- Players not following the established playing sequence lose their standing.
- To avoid unnecessary delays players must let the following group through if:

- o There is one clear hole ahead
- o Searching for a ball
- o The rules of standing are applicable

DRESS CODE

- All players must wear proper clothing.
- T-shirts, jeans, trainers and bathing shorts are not allowed. All players must wear shirts with collars.

ETIQUETTE

- Please rake bunkers, replace divots and repair pitch marks.
- Keep buggies away from Greens, Tees and Surroundings.
- It is forbidden for more than 2 persons to ride a buggy at one time.
- Dogs are not allowed on the course.
- The management regrets that they cannot be held responsible for the loss or the damage to any valuables on the golf course or around the Club House;
- Respect Wildlife.
